What DPV fields should be added to a job and what do they contain?

Below are the DPV fields and what they are populated with when DPV processing is performed. The software will process a job without these fields, but it is recommended to add them to the file.

DPV_CMRA (DPV CMRA):

This field is populated during processing to note if the address is a valid Commercial Mail Receiving Agency CMRA.

- **Y = The address is a valid Commercial Mail Receiving Agency.**
- **N = The address is not a valid Commercial Mail Receiving Agency.**
- **L = The address triggered DPV locking.**
- **Blank = This component is blank when the DPV mode is turned off, the input address cannot be assigned, or DPV processing is locked.**

DPV_STATUS (DPV Status):

This field is populated during processing to note if the address is a confirmed delivery point. Codes returned in this field are as follows:

- **Y = The address is a confirmed delivery point. The primary range (e.g. house number) and secondary range (e.g. apt. number) (if present) are valid.**
- **S = The primary range (e.g. house number) is a valid delivery point, but the secondary range (e.g. apt. number) is not valid in the DPV directory.**
- **D = The primary range (e.g. house number) is a valid delivery point, but the parsed secondary range data (e.g. apt. number) is not available on input.**
- **L = This address triggered DPV Locking.**
- **N = The address is not a valid delivery point (why was the N assigned).**
- **Blank = This component is blank when the DPV mode is not set to VALIDATE or BOTH, DPV processing is currently locked, or the program cannot assign the input address.**

DPV_NOSTAT (DPV No Stats):

This field indicates whether the address is a vacant property, it receives mail as a part of a drop, or it does not have an established delivery yet. The returned values are as follows:

- **Y = Address is flagged as No Stat in DPV data.**
- **N = Address is not No Stat.**
- **blank = Address was not looked up.**

DPV_VACANT (DPV Vacant Indicator):

A vacant delivery point is any delivery point that was active in the past but is currently not occupied and not receiving mail. When an address is marked as vacant, it may receive mail in the future. This is not an indicator of seasonal addresses.

- **Y = Address is vacant.**
- **N = Address is not vacant.**
- **Blank = Address was not looked up.**
